

Arrival by Car (Osorno)

Osorno to Santa Elvira:

1. From Osorno, head east to Puyehue on route 215 (toward Entre Lagos).
2. 14 km (8.7 miles) after passing Entre Lagos, turn **right** to Santa Elvira/ El Encanto.
3. After approx. 7 km (4.35 miles), turn **left** on the road to Santa Elvira - 400m (0.25 miles) after the pavement ends. Stay approx. 13 km (8 miles) on that road.
4. Stay on the main road until you reach the end. This is the Santa Elvira bus stop. (Look out for the **wooden gate** on your **right**).

Santa Elvira to Aluantu:

GPS coordinates: -40.870195,-72.320160

1. At Santa Elvira you will find a wooden gate on your **right**, directly opposite a white house. Pass through the gate and drive down 100 m (330 ft). You'll notice a small **wooden bridge** to the **right** with a wooden gate on the other side of the bridge. Cross the bridge carefully and go through the gate.
2. Drive another 100 m (330 ft) and you'll see another **wooden gate**. Ask for the gatekeeper (Freddy) and tell him you're going to Aluantu (Lago Rupanco).
3. Drive ahead and stay on the main road. Keep left and pass the "**Casas Lago Rupanco**" sign. (*do not turn right*).
4. Keep always on the main road, until you get to a T-junction with a sign that has "**Los Arrayanes**" written on it. Turn **right** at the sign. This route will take you to the Aluantu Lodge. The sign is pictured in the map.
5. Drive straight down the path, you will find a first gate, go through it. (Please close the gate).
6. After a while you will find a second wooden gate with a roof over it and a vegetable garden to the left, also go through it. (Please close the gate).
7. After a third gate and a big curve, at the lake's edge, you will arrive at Aluantu.

Please head to the main lodge for reception.
